Basic Covered Services	Primary Care Visits, Immunizations, Family Planning, Pregnancy, Hospital Services, Home Health Care, Wellness, and Emergent/Urgent Care		
Prescription Medication	Mail Order Pharmacy 90-day refill supply available on select medications <i>For Medicaid coverage only. Medicare and other insurance co-pays may still apply.</i>		
Over-the-Counter Medication	Select medically necessary over-the-counter medications are covered when prescribed by a provider.		
Dental Services	Cleaning of teeth, fillings, extractions, x-rays, dental surgery, and dental disease control.		
Vision Care Services	Eyeglasses, including lenses and frames, are covered when coverage criteria is met. Examination, diagnosis, and treatment services to diagnose or treat a specific eye illness, symptom, complaint, or injury.		
Hearing Aid Services	Hearing aids, hearing aid repairs, necessary batteries, and supplies are covered.		
Therapies	Speech, physical, and occupational therapies in the office, in the client’s home, hospital, nursing facilities, or other facilities. The services must be prescribed by a physician. Therapy is limited to restoration of lost function due to illness or injury if you are age 20 and older. Medicaid will cover up to 60 combined visits per year.		
Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services for Children and Adolescents	Mental health and substance abuse services for children and adolescents, including outpatient services, middle intensity services, day treatment, and hospital services.		



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Adult Psychiatric and Substance Use Disorder	Medically necessary psychiatric and substance use disorder services for primary psychiatric and/or substance use disorder diagnoses for individuals age 21 and older, including outpatient services, day treatment, substance use disorder treatment, and hospital services.		
Member with Special Health Care Needs	Care coordination of discharge planning with a focus on the seriously mentally ill population, members with special needs, short-term and long-term hospital stays, and other institutions, such as juvenile institutions.		
Care Management	Patient-centered care that addresses medical, dental, vision, behavioral health, and social determinants of health care needs. An accessible, comprehensive, fully integrated array of preventive and treatment services for all age groups that focuses on the whole person and empowers the member to participate with their medical home, dental home, specialists, and other care providers to effectively manage health conditions and prevent complications.		
Pregnancy Management	Medical care for pregnant mothers, including labor and delivery, and 12 months of continuous postpartum coverage.		
Disease Management	Structured, coordinated care management program focused on managing chronic disease, reducing acute episodes and disease complications, and improving quality of life. Comprehensive support for activities and interventions associated with treatment plans. Health conditions that benefit from disease management include, but are not limited to: Asthma, Bipolar disorder, Coronary artery disease (CAD), Congestive heart failure (CHF), Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), Diabetes, HIV/AIDS, Hypertension, Major depressive disorder (MDD), Schizophrenia, and Substance use disorder (SUD).

**Healthy Meals for Moms:** Meals sent to members’ home during pregnancy and while breastfeeding after birth.

**Prenatal Dental Care:** Pregnant members can get one extra dental cleaning.

**Family Fun Time:** Each household with children can get a permit for unlimited visits to Nebraska’s state parks for one year.

**WeightWatchers®:** Up to 13 weeks of WeightWatchers® services.

**Get Fit, Stay Fit:** Support once a year to help pay for a gym membership or fitness equipment.

**Personal Care and Household Items:** Support every quarter to buy commonly used personal care and household items.

**Healthy Rewards Program:** Gift cards for completing preventive care visits and screenings.

**TruConnect:** Members who qualify for the federal Lifeline program can get 4.5GB of data and unlimited talk and text.

**Additional Dental Exams:** Two extra dental checkups for specific problems.



**Doula Services:** In person pregnancy guidance and support from certified Doulas for members who qualify.

**My Health Pays:** Rewards for completing healthy activities like a yearly wellness exam, annual screenings, infant and children’s care and other ways to protect your health.

**Community Garden:** Sponsorship for plots to grow healthy foods and education on nutrition and health.

**Weight Watchers:** Memberships for eligible members.

**GED Testing Materials:** Study materials to prepare for GED testing.

**ConnectionsPlus:** Cell phone for members who qualify without reliable access to a telephone.

**Practice Dental Visits:** For children with special needs.



**Substance Use Disorder Helpline:** An anonymous confidential helpline to a licensed substance use expert for information on substance use disorder treatment.

**Online Mental Health Resources:** Self-help tools and family support library for members.

**Calm Health:** A digital treatment whole-person support self-help app that offers mindfulness meditation for stress, anxiety, and depression. Members can download the Calm Health app to receive on-demand support at any time.

**GED Program:** Members can receive help with getting their GED. Limitations apply.

**Cell Phone Service:** Members who qualify receive minutes, text and data per month when using their own cell phone.

**Non-Medical Transportation:** Rides within 10-mile radius to WIC appointments, prenatal and parenting classes, worship, retail store, employment preparation, food pantry, support group meetings, community center, limited to 48 one-way rides per year.

<p><b>Everyday Transportation:</b> Rides to places like the grocery store, food pantry, pharmacy, and Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) appointments.</p> <p><b>Molina Help Finder:</b> On-demand, 24/7 access to thousands of community resources across the state.</p> <p><b>Healthy Meals for Recovery :</b> Meals sent to members’ home to support their nutritional needs during recovery after they leave the hospital.</p>		<p><b>Social Service Referrals:</b> A web-based application to identify the best fit for your social services needs. Services include housing support, food, health education and support groups, job training, home goods, legal support and more.</p> <p><b>Healthy Rewards Program:</b> Eligible members can earn rewards for well care visits, immunizations, and preventive dental care.</p> <p><b>Door and Window Alarms:</b> Up to six per household for members with disabilities to help minimize wandering.</p>

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
